Summer tends to bring a much slower pace to life - the kids are off school, people are booking annual leave - but not for Optimised Retrofit.

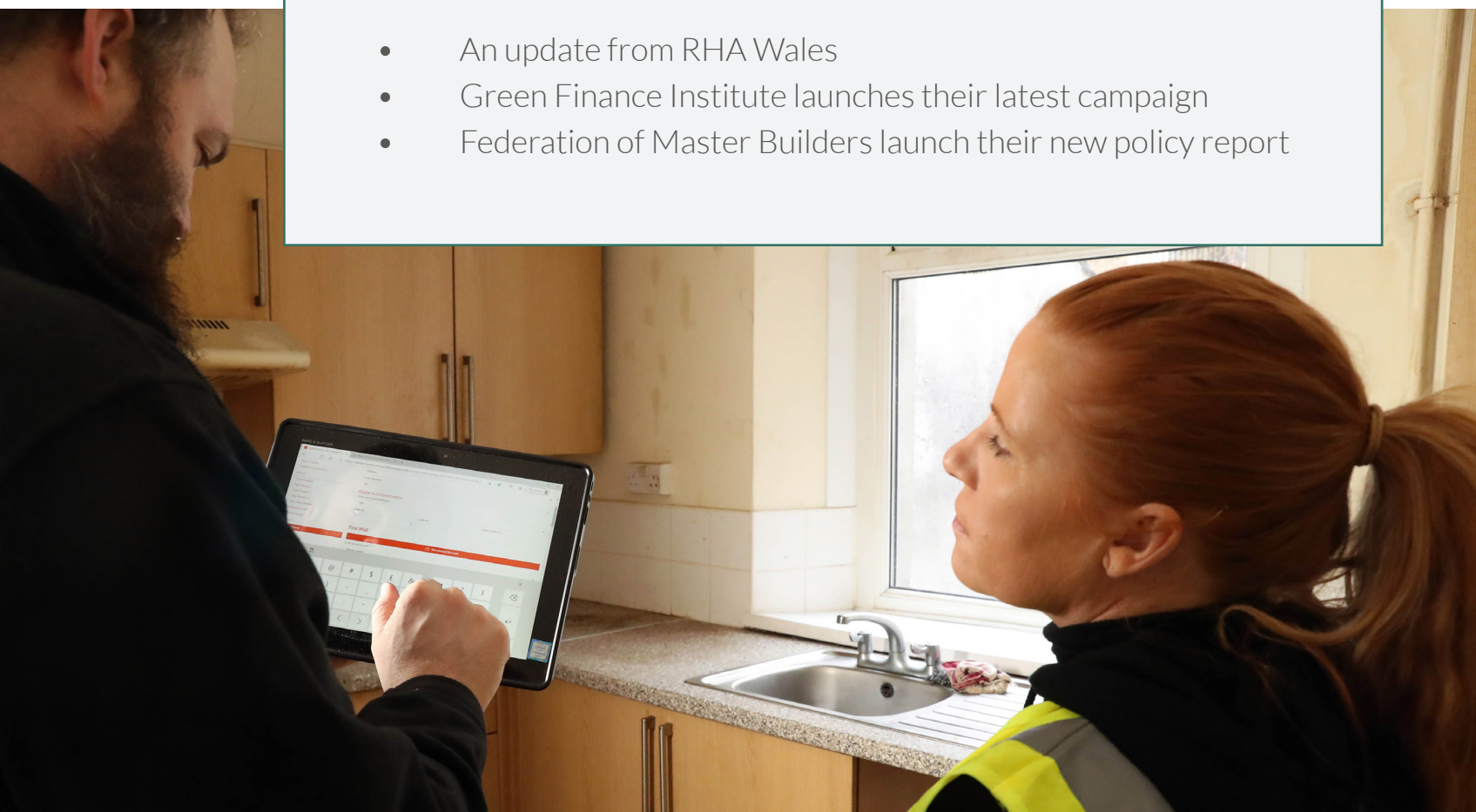
We have been hard at it, developing strategies that will influence our future approach and providing training for our partners to support them in delivering the project on the ground.

Pathfinder Homes

Earlier this year RHA, one of our registered social landlord partners, launched their first decarbonisation strategy, 'RHA Optimise'.

This outlines their commitment to reduce their carbon emissions and use less energy through all of their activities including their offices and commercial buildings, their homes and their ways of working.

Their work in this area presents a real opportunity for partnership working and collaboration.

“ *As a result of the pandemic restrictions, we had to rethink our original plans to survey each home first so instead we installed solar PV and battery storage to twelve homes that we knew would benefit from them based on our knowledge of the homes.* ”

We were aware of the Welsh manufactured Solar PV panels that locally based GB-Sol develop and they have worked with us to install Solar PV and battery storage to the twelve homes in Llanharry. Solar PV systems have been shown to reduce electricity bills by providing free electricity to the occupants.

However, the difference with this project was the addition of a battery to enable any unused energy generated to be stored for use at a time when the Solar PV panels are not generating electricity.

Moving forward we will be taking an optimised retrofit approach where we will develop an individual plan for each home with the aim of reaching EPC A on as many as homes possible by 2030, in line with the recommendations of 'Better Homes, Better Wales, Better World' and Welsh Government targets.

Local Climate Bonds

In July 2021 the Green Finance Institute and Abundance launched the Local Climate Bond campaign, to raise awareness and support participating councils through the process of releasing their own Local Climate Bonds in the year of COP26.

Local Climate Bonds have the potential to raise millions of pounds for green projects in the UK.

They are finance products launched by councils to access cost-effective funding for specific decarbonisation projects, offering local people an opportunity to invest in their area in a way

similar to crowdfunding and to make a return from doing so. As the appetite for place-based finance products grows, it is hoped that other investment platforms will join Abundance in supporting councils to offer Local Climate Bonds.

Building on our strengths: A market transformation approach to energy retrofit in UK homes
